This Indenture made and entered into this twenty fourth day of March in the year
 our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty between Thomas R. Gray of the County
 Virginia of the State of Virginia and County of Southampton of the first part and Miss
 A. Broome of the same State and County of the second part Witnesseth that the said
 Gray for and in consideration of the sum of Three thousand five hundred dollars to
 him by the said A. Broome paid or secure to be paid before the sealing and delivery of
 these presents which he as his own hereby acknowledged has bargained sold and conveyed
 and by these presents does bargain and sell and convey unto him the said Broome a certain tract
 or parcel of Land lying and being situate in the said County of Southampton containing by
 late survey Five hundred acres and bounded as follows To wit Beginning at a pine stake
 in Edwards White line of Mr. James Briggs land thence North 89 degrees East 18 1/2 poles to
 point the corner in Edwards White land thence North 80 degrees East 44 poles to a stake
 at 87 degrees East 60 poles to a red oak corner in Volney Briggs line thence North 14
 West 39 1/2 poles to a pine the corner of John Urquhart's Land and the 1st corner thence
 North 68 degrees West 24 1/2 poles to a pine in the main branch thence down the main branch
 of said branch to the road at Mr. James Briggs line thence up the said road South 14 degrees
 East 39 1/2 poles to the beginning To have and to hold the said Granted premises with
 appurtenances to him the said A. Broome and his heirs and assigns and his heirs and assigns
 proper use and behoof forever and the said Gray for himself and his heirs covenants to go
 with the said Broome and his heirs that he shall have and enjoy a good and perfect title to
 said bargained premises and have quiet possession of the same In Testimony whereof

 Southampton and State of Virginia of the other part Witnesseth that the said Samuel Daughtery and
 Polly his wife in consideration of the sum of one thousand dollars to them in hand paid by the said Matthew Daughtery
 at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof they the said
 Samuel Daughtery and Polly do hereby acknowledge and that of forever remonstrate against and
 discharge him the said Matthew Daughtery his heirs Executors and administrators here granted and
 sold aliened enfeoffed and confirmed and by these presents do grant buy and sell alien and
 confirm unto the said Matthew Daughtery and his heirs forever a certain piece or parcel of Land
 containing two hundred and ninety three acres and being the same more or less situate and being in the
 County of Southampton and State of Virginia and containing the following Bounded Beginning
 at a white oak standing near the road that leads from Pauls Run to Emeralds and a mile
 Jeremiah Gardner thence North 44th 12 pole North 57th 12 pole North 15th 18 pole North 2th 12 pole North
 17th 14 pole North 6th 14 pole North 12th 20 pole to Barney Edwards line thence along Barney Edwards
