 said William Griffin being advised and willing to secure the said Allen Edwards from having to pay the above
 debt or any part thereof has and does think proper to make over in trust certain property to secure him from
 any harm or injury which may accrue to him for being his security aforesaid from this Indenture Whose
 witness that for and in consideration of the premises and also for the further consideration of the sum of one dollar
 to him in hand paid by the said Joseph Turner the First part at or before the sealing and delivery of
 these presents the receipts whereof is hereby acknowledged the said William Griffin hath given
 granted bargained and sold and by these presents do give grant bargain and sell unto the said Joseph
 Turner his heirs assigns or assigns forever the following property one acre and a quarter Tompkins one acre
 long Jim one bay mare six head of Cattle and two heather head and furniture together with all the
 singular the aforesaid things property as well the future or create thereof and all the Estate rights title
 and interest of him the said William Griffin in and to the said granted property To have and to
 hold the said hereby granted property in all every part and parcel thereof unto the said Joseph Turner
