This Indenture made this 17 day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty one Between Lazarus Johnson of the County of Isle of Wight on the one part and Soyner of the County of Southampton of the other part. WHEREAS the said Lazarus Johnson in Consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars of lawful money of this Commonwealth to him in hand paid by the said Eliza Soyner at or before the executing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged Have bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain and sell unto the said Eliza Soyner his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in or between Townships in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia containing by estimation One hundred and fifty acres be the same more or less, siting a tract of land owned by Richard Worrell and willed by him to his son Richard who died intestate and in consequence of which the said land descended to sundry persons heirs at law of the said Richard Worrell and was sold by them to a certain Thomas Johnson the father of the said Lazarus and bounded as follows to wit Beginning at a Black gum in grove by and thence a line marked to a post oak a corner in Samuel Turner's line, thence a line of marked trees to a gum in Enoch Turner in the head of a small branch, thence down said branch some distance and thence a line of marked to the head of a gravel run in road from thence down said gravel run to the beginning with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining to the same or any part or parcel thereof To have and to hold the said 150 acres of land unto the tenements and appurtenances thereto belonging unto the said Eliza Soyner his heirs & assigns forever to and for the only proper use and behoof of him the said Eliza Soyner his heirs and assigns forever and the said Lazarus Johnson for himself and his heirs the said land with all and singular the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said Eliza Soyner his heirs and assigns free from the claim or demand of him the said Lazarus Johnson and all other persons as far as his interest claiming and by future's Will may extend whatsoever shall and well tenant and forever defend by their persons.
