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and demands to secure also all other debts or claims by bond or otherwise which the said
 Sick R Strong & Co may hereafter hold against the said Joseph Drury and this
 Indenture witnesses that the said Joseph Drury for and in consideration of the
 money and also for the further consideration of One dollar of lawful money of England
 to him in hand paid by the said Edgar H Parsons the receipt whereof is hereby
 acknowledged by the said Joseph Drury has granted bargained and sold and
 by these presents does grant bargain and sell unto the said Edgar H Parsons
 his Executors and Administrators the following named negro Slaves to wit one
 negro woman by the name of Nanny and an infant male child negro girls known
 Edith, Matilda and Hannah and the future increase of the aforesaid female negro
 Slaves. To have and to hold the hereby granted or intended to be hereby granted
 negro Slaves and the future increase of the females thereof unto the said Edgar
 H Parsons his heirs Executors or agent. To the only proper use and
 behoof of the said Edgar H Parsons his Executors Administrators or Agent upon
 Trust nevertheless that the said Joseph Drury is to retain possession of the aforesaid
 negro Slaves until the said Sick R Strong and Co or their Executors Admin^{rs} or agents
 shall direct the said Edgar H Parsons his Executor or agent to take possession
 of the same and after ascertaining the time and place of sale for the said
 Parsons as Trustee as aforesaid shall sell the said negro Slaves and the future increase
 of the females thereof or such part of them as may be necessary to satisfy the aforesaid
 debt and interest and also all other debts which the said Sick R Strong & Co may hold
 against the said Drury at the time of such sale for cash to the highest bidder and
 of the proceeds of such sale pay first the expenses of this Trust then the debt aforesaid
 with the interest which shall have accrued thereon and also all other debts or claims by
 bond or otherwise which the said Sick R Strong & Co may hold against the said
 Joseph Drury and the balance if any pay to the said Joseph Drury or his order
 But if the said Joseph Drury his Executor or Admin^r shall at any time before the said
 shall have been made pay to the said Strong and Co their Admin^r or agents
 the aforesaid sum or sums of money then due with interest thereon and the balance
 thereof then the said Strong and Co their heirs &c. Covenant that the said negro
 Slaves and the future increase of the females thereof shall be fully released to him
 the said Joseph Drury his heirs Executors or Admin^r of their incumbrances and
 the said Joseph Drury for himself his heirs Executors and Admin^r covenants
 that the said negro Slaves and the future increase of the females thereof
 shall be delivered up for their purposes whenever applied for and he the said
 Joseph Drury did hereby warrant and defend the title of the aforesaid negro
 Slaves and the future increase of the females thereof In Witness whereof
 the parties to these presents have hereunto set their hands and seals the day
 and year above written
