

to the said Francis Lenox, Exec of Henry Lenox dec'd. by Indenture of Trust of that date conveyed to the said John Eames his heirs Execs. the following tract or parcel of land to wit, which was conveyed by Deed of Trust bearing date January 2nd 1633. to John Eames Trustee for the then use of Henry Lenox upon Trust for the use and purposes in the said Indenture mentioned and whereas since the executing and delivery of the said Deed of Trust the said Court Baron Sheriff and Committee of the estate of Lawrence Joppin dec'd. hath fully satisfied and paid to the said Francis Lenox, Execs. the sum of money therein secured, which the said Francis Lenox dec'd. doth hereby acknowledge, And whereas the said John Eames hath for the Considerations aforesaid as well as for the further Consideration of one dollar and some paid by the said Court Baron Sheriff and Committee of the estate of Lawrence Joppin dec'd. to the said John Eames at and before the executing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said John Eames with the assent and approbation of the said Francis Lenox, Executors of Henry Lenox dec'd. signified by her being party to these presents, and the said Francis Lenox dec'd. hath granted, forgiven and sold Remission & Release and Confirms unto the said Court Baron Sheriff & Committee of the estate of Lawrence Joppin dec'd. all the Estate, Right Title, interest claim and demand both at Law and in Equity, which the said John Eames and Francis Lenox Execs. have or hold in the said above described Tract to have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land to the said Court Baron Sheriff and Committee of Est of Lawrence Joppin dec'd. his heirs Executors administrators and assigns forever to the only proper use and behoof of them the said Court Baron Sheriff and Committee of Est of Lawrence Joppin his heirs Executors administrators and assigns And the said John Eames and Francis Lenox Execs. for themselves their heirs Executors administrators the above mentioned land into the said Court Baron Sheriff and Committee of the estate of Lawrence Joppin his heirs Executors administrators and assigns in as full and ample manner as the same was warranted by the said Lawrence Joppin by the Deed of Trust above recited do warrant the same to the said Court Baron Sheriff Committee of Lawrence Joppin's estate against the claim or claims of them the said John Eames and Francis Lenox Execs. and all persons claiming by or under them or either of them.
