This Indenture made this 25th day of August in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand eight hundred and thirty four between William Davis of the County of Lincoln and parish of Stottoway of the one part and John Holloman of the County and parish of the other part: Witnesseth that the said William Davis in and in consideration of the sum of ten dollars good and lawful money of the United States to him in hand paid by the said John Holloman the receipt whereof the said William Davis doth acknowledge himself fully and amply satisfied and he hath granted bargained sold aliened conveyed and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said John Holloman his heirs and assigns one certain tract or parcel of land and premises Situate lying and being in the aforesaid Containing by estimation three and one third acres be the same more or less bounded as follows to wit Beginning at a Spring upon the East side of the road called Proctor's Road in John Holloman's line thence Eastward along said Holloman's line to a fence a corner in James Wequhart's line thence Northward along said James Wequhart's line to a small black gum a corner in said James Wequhart's line thence Northward along said James Wequhart's line to a large pine in the side of said Proctor Road thence along the said Proctor Road Northward to the first lot together with all houses out houses edifices buildings yards gardens orchards meadows and Water Courses Whats ever belonging or in any wise appertaining thereto. To have and to hold the said land and premises to him and his heirs forever. And the said William Davis for himself his heirs &c. doth by these presents Covenant and grant to and with the said John Holloman his heirs assigns that he will by these presents warrantly and forever defend all right claim or demand of any person or persons claiming or demanding the said land and premises or parcel thereof.
