

The Indenture made the Twenty eighth day of July between *James* *hundred* & *Henry* four the-  
*same* *Mary* *Hill* of the County of *Southampton* and State of *Virginia* of the One part and  
*John* *Barratt* of the same County and State of the other part *Witnesseth* that the  
*same* *Mary* *Hill* in Consideration of the sum of *Eighty* dollars Current Money of the  
 Commonwealth to her in hand paid by the said *John* *Barratt* at or before the execution  
 and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged has her-  
 self and sole and by these presents do bargain and sell unto the said *John* *Barratt*  
 with his heirs and assigns forever One half of my right, title, interest, Claim in and to the  
 same land of *Patty* *Hill* widow of *Sam* *Hill* dec<sup>d</sup> which is our fourth part of said  
 the said Land with all and singular the Appurtenances thereto belonging unto the  
 said *John* *Barratt* his heirs and assigns forever, To and for the full proper use and behoof  
 of him the said *John* *Barratt* his heirs and assigns forever, And the said *Mary* *Hill*  
 has her self executed administrations and assigns the said parcel of Land with all and sin-  
 gular the premises and Appurtenances before mentioned or hereunto belonging unto  
 the said *John* *Barratt* his heirs and assigns forever from the Claim of her the said *Mary*  
*Hill* his heirs executors, administrators or assigns, and free from the Claim or Claims of  
 all and every person or persons what so ever shall call and do Law and and force  
 defend the right and title of said Land for these presents. In *Witness* whereof  
 the said *Mary* *Hill* have hereunto set her hand and affixed her seal the day and  
 year first above written.

 of the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars to us in hand paid by *Joseph* *D* *Claw*  
 at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby  
 acknowledged) have bargain and sell, grant and confirmed, and by these pres-  
 ents do bargain and sell grant and conform to the said *Joseph* *D* *Claw* two certain  
 and shew to *W* *(Stirling* *&* *Mingo)* which said slaves are the due property of  
*Lucey* *Rumsey* late *Lucey* *Marrison* and *W* *at* her death by *Rec* *John* *Stevenson*  
 her former husband to us, To have and to hold the said slaves (*Stirling* and *Mingo*) and  
 all our Interest, Claim or demand in the remissionary rights in the said slaves of what  
 so ever kind it may be to the only proper use and behoof of said *Joseph* *D* *Claw*  
 his heirs executors, admors and assigns forever and all the said *W* *at* *John* *Stevenson*  
*Richard* *C* *Davis* and *Thomas* *James* in right of his *Wife* *Charl* for our selves our
