William & wife This Indenture made and entered into this Twentieth day of July One  
to thousand eight hundred and thirty five between Jacob Williams and Rachel  
Edwards his wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one  
part and Peter Edwards of the same County and State of the other part  
Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of four hundred dollars  
in hand paid to the said Williams by the said Edwards the receipt of which  
is hereby acknowledged the said Jacob Williams and Rachel his wife  
of the first part have granted bargained and sold and by these presents  
do grant bargain and sell unto the said Peter Edwards of the second  
part One certain tract or parcel of land being and being in the County  
and State aforesaid and being the tract of same lately purchased of William  
Porter by the said Jacob Williams and on which the said Williams Porter and  
successors by any names the swamps called Bohun's swamp and Revis swamp  
and bounded as follows on the North by the land of the said Peter Edwards  
on the East by the lands of George Whitfield & James Pavee on the South  
by the lands of James Pavee and on the West by the lands of Edmund  
Underwood & Elizabeth Atkinson The said tract containing One hundred &  
sixty five Acres more or less with all the privileges improvements and  
appurtenances therunto belonging To have and to hold to the said Peter  
Edwards his heirs and assigns forever. And we the said <sup>party</sup> Williams and  
Rachel his wife do hereby warrant and defend against the title of the  
said Land to the said Peter Edwards his heirs and assigns against the  
Claim or Claims of any and every person whatsoever In Witness whereof  
we have hereunto set our hands and affixed our seals the day and date  
first above written.
