paid by the said Alexander Myrick at or before the executing and delivery of these presents (the receipt whereof is
hereby acknowledged) have bargained and sold and by these presents doth bargain and sell unto the said
Alexander Myrick and his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the
County of Southampton aforesaid containing one hundred and twenty acres more or less being the tract of Land which the
said Martha Barnett hired from her Father and set number two as well more fully appraised by reference
to Commissioners Report in the Clerk's Office of aforesaid County, Together with all and singular the appur-
tenances to the said tract or parcel of Land belonging or in any wise appertaining, So have and to hold the
said tract or parcel of Land and premises unto him the said Alexander Myrick his heirs and assigns
for the only proper use and behoof of him the said Alexander Myrick his heirs and assigns forever, And
the said Martha Barnett for herself her heirs Executors and administrators hereby covenants and agrees to and
with the said Alexander Myrick his heirs and assigns that she will warrant and forever defend the title
to the aforesaid tract of Land to him the said Alexander Myrick his heirs and assigns against the claims or
demand of her the said Martha Barnett and of all every person or persons whatsoever. In testimony
