

The sale made by the said Commissioner Clump on the 18th day of February 1859, subject to the dower of the widow of the said Story therein the said heirs being the parties herein aforesaid of the second part it being considered by said court that the said Jacobus Story had died intestate as to said land, all which will more fully appear by reference to the said last mentioned decree. Now this Evidence made & entered into as aforesaid, Witnesseth that the said Sazwell Taylor special commissioner as aforesaid by virtue of the authority vested in him by the said last mentioned decree and in execution of the same for and in consideration of the payment aforesaid to him of the said sum of one hundred & forty four dollars & seventy cents by the said administrator of the said Jacobus Story deceased as well as of the premises aforesaid, does grant and convey unto the said Levi W. Story, Emily Whitfield Martha Ann Pope and Eliza Rebecca Jane Story heirs as aforesaid of the said Jacobus Story deceased the tract of land which the said Jacobus Story purchased as aforesaid of the said R. A. Clump, Commissioner being described as a tract of land of which Clements Rockwell did seized lying in the county of Southampton aforesaid known as the "Becca Beek" tract containing by old survey eighty two acres and adjoining the lands of the said Jacobus Story and the land of John E. Beale. To have & to hold the said tract of land with the appurtenances to the same belonging unto them the said parties of the second part, in fee simple and their heirs and assigns subject to the dower right therein of the widow of the said Jacobus Story deceased, of him the said Sazwell Taylor Commissioner as aforesaid, with special warranty.
