Rockwell's full and equal moiety in value of a certain tract or parcel of land lying partly in the Counties of Southampton and Sussex supposed to contain fifteen hundred acres be the same more or less formerly owned by Sam^l. B. Hines together with all and singular the more or less demands in any manner appertaining. And afterwards on the 26th day of December 1850 the said John W. Rockwell & Beale his wife by their certain dec which was admitted to Record on the 13th day of January 1851 did convey unto Littleton R. Edwards all their (the said Rockwell & wife's) interest, being one moiety in value in a certain tract or parcel of land lying in the Counties of Southampton and Sussex, supposed to contain fifteen hundred acres more or less, being the lands formerly owned by Samuel B. Hines. The interest conveyed by this last being the same which was conveyed by the dec first above referred to, to William B. Shaws to secure the payment of the debt due William D. Clarke. And whereas since the execution of the dec aforesaid of the 26th day of December 1850 the said Littleton R. Edwards has fully paid off and discharged the debt aforesaid due from the said John W. Rockwell to the said William D. Clarke, which he the said Clarke does hereby acknowledge, and does require of the said Clarke & Shaws to release to him the said Edwards the interest which was conveyed by the said John W. Rockwell by the dec first before referred to. Now in consideration of the premises as well as of the sum of one dollar to the said Shaws in hand paid he the said Shaws with the consent & approbation of the said Clarke, and the said do hereby remise, release and convey unto the said Littleton R. Edwards the interest which was conveyed by the said John W. Rockwell to the said William B. Shaws by the first above referred to to secure the debt due the said William D. Clarke. And the said Shaws and Clarke warrant and defend the interest hereby released and conveyed unto the said Littleton R. Edwards his heirs & assigns against themselves the said Shaws & Clarke and those claiming or demanding the same or any part thereof by, through or under them, but against the claim, title or demand of no other person or persons whatsoever.
