 confirmed, and by these presents doth give, grant, bargain, sell, alien, en-
 feoff, release, and confirm to the said Thos. B. Norrell trustee his heirs
 and assigns forever, Three certain Tracts or parcels of land and premises
 situate, lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton & parish of
 St. Julies. Containing six hundred and thirty seven and one fourth acres
 be the same more or less, being the three tracts or parcels of land,
 the said Sth H. Bishop purchased of said Joseph C. Lillie, as will
 appear by his Deed to said Bishop, executed and bearing date this day,
 wherein the said three tracts or parcels of land, and their boundaries are
 described: To have and to hold the said hereby granted or intended to be hereby
 granted three tracts or parcels of land and premises with their appurtenances
 unto the said Thos. B. Norrell trustee his heirs, Executors, adms, and assigns
 forever, and the said Sth H. Bishop, for himself, his heirs, Executors,
 and administrators, doth hereby covenant, promise and agree, to and
