Shields & Martha his wife of the one part, and Alex^r Faison and John Holt of the other part, and all of the State of Virginia: Witnesseth that the said Polly Branch, Mary W. Bettle and Exam W. Shields & Martha his wife for and in consideration of the sum of Four hundred and fifty dollars to them in hand paid or otherwise come, by said Alex^r Faison & John Holt, at or before the sealing & delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath granted, bargained and sold and by these presents do grant, bargain & sell, alien, enjoy, and confirm to the said Alex^r Faison & John Holt and to their heirs and assigns forever all their right, title, claim & interest in one certain tract or parcel of land, containing three hundred & sixty three acres more or less lying and being in the County of Southampton and formerly belonging to the estate of Jas. Williamson dec^d known as the Store tract, and bounded as follows, to wit: On the west by Arthur W. S. S. on the north by the land formerly belonging to Jas. S. Gooding dec^d on the East by R. Elphinstone & white south of this: Pitman, together with all trees, woods, underwoods, both common and advantages, hereditaments, & appurtenances to the said land belonging or in any wise appertaining and also the reversion and reversions, remainder and remainders, rights & services of the said premises and every part thereof, and all the estate, right, title, interest, claim or demand whatsoever of them the said Polly Branch, Mary W. Bettle & Exam W. Shields & Martha his wife their heirs &c, in or to the said premises or any part thereof: To have and to hold, all and singular the premises above mentioned and every part and parcel thereof, with the appurtenances unto the said Alex^r Faison & John Holt their heirs and assigns forever and the said Polly Branch, Mary W.
