






This Indenture made and entered into on this 7<sup>th</sup> day of April in the year of our Lord eight hundred and fifty five, between Benjamin J. Byrant & Mary A. Byrant his wife and Richard L. Byrant, all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Norfleet B. Cutler of the same County and State of the other part, Witnesseth that the said Benjamin J. Byrant & Mary A. his wife and Richard L. Byrant for and in consideration of the sum of fifty hundred and thirty five dollars to them in hand paid by the said Norfleet B. Cutler at or before the making and delivery of these presents, the receipts whereof is hereby acknowledged as have granted, bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto him the said Norfleet B. Cutler his Heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of land with the gravae and excepted situated lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and Parish of Saint Lukes containing by estimation two hundred and thirty acres or thereabouts more or less; it being the tract of land formerly owned by Williams S. Daniels and whereon he has heretofore resided and bounded by the Lands of Roswell Powell William C. Myrick, Josiah Omsted's Heirs, Jacob Barnes Coy. and others. So have covenants held the above described tract or parcel of land and premises with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining unto him the said Norfleet B. Cutler his Heirs and assigns forever, to and for the only proper use and behoof of him the said Norfleet B. Cutler his Heirs and assigns forever. And the said Benjamin J. Byrant & Mary A. his wife and Richard L. Byrant for themselves their Heirs, Executors and Administrators do hereby covenant and agree to and with the said Norfleet B. Cutler his Heirs, Executors, Administrators and assigns that they will by these presents warrant and forever defend all the right and title of the aforesaid tract or parcel of land and premises and every part and parcel thereof against the claims or demands of all and every other person or persons whatsoever. In Witness whereof the said Benjamin J. Byrant & Mary A. his wife and Richard L. Byrant have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals the day and year first above writteth.
