Thousand seven hundred and eighty three Between William
Wick son of Richard of Southampton County State of Virginia
of the one part & Pilgrim Wick of the said County of the other
part Witnesseth that the said William Wick for and
in consideration of the sum of five shillings Current
Money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said Pilgrim
Wick the Receipt Whereof the said William Wick doth hereby
acknowledge hath granted bargain conveyed and
confirmed, and by these presents doth grant bargain sell
convey and confirm unto the said Pilgrim Wick his heirs
and assigns forever, one Certain Tract or parcel of Land lying
and being in the County aforesaid containing by estimation
two Hundred acres less the same be more or less, and
bounded as followeth to wit Beginning at a post oak &
corner of Wm. Newsums Land thence by the said Newsums
Land to Council Wicks Line thence along the said Council Wicks
Line
