This indenture made the 15th day of the month of

his wife found in the Court of the sum of Fifty five  
pounds Current Money of the said City of Southampton  
before the undersigned Justice of the Peace the receipt  
whereof they do hereby acknowledge hath granted bargained  
sold aliened released and confirmed and by these presents doth  
grant bargain sell alien release & confirm unto the said  
Richard Beale his heirs and assigns all that Plantation tract  
of land containing by estimation one hundred acres  
more or less situated lying & beginning at a poplar  
in the north east side of the Gravely run thence north  
forty degrees east sixty six poles to a oak near the Cypress  
swamp then north thirty five degrees west two hundred &  
fifty four poles to a white oak then south forty degrees  
west sixty six poles to a pine by the side of the Gravely  
run thence and down the various courses of the  
run of the said Gravely run to the Beginning the said  
land being granted by George the second King of Great  
Britain France and Ireland King defender of the faith  
unto Thomas Mercer bearing date the twentieth day of  
September one thousand seven hundred & forty five duly  
proved & recorded in the Court of the aforesaid City of  
Southampton, granted to him the said Thomas Mercer &  
to his heirs and assigns forever all houses out houses  
trees woods Commons, Commons of Pastures profits  
Commodities Advantages emoluments hereditaments and  
appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise  
appertaining whatsoever to the said lands houses  
mentioned in or upon the said growing happening or  
arising the reversion or reversions remainder & remainders  
rents services of the premises & every part thereof and  
also all the Estate right Title interest claim Demand  
Whatsoever of them the said Henry Pope & Charity his  
wife of in or to the same premises & every part thereof  
to have and to hold all and singular the premises  
above mentioned & every part thereof with the appurtenances  
unto the said Richard Beale his heirs and assigns  
to the only proper use and behoof of him the said Richard  
Beale
