Nicholson of Southampton County & State of Virginia of the one part, & Littleton Part of the County & State of Virginia of the other part, Witnesseth that the said Charles B. Nicholson for and in Consideration of the sum of eight pounds twelve shillings & six pence, current money of Virginia to him in hand paid, have bargained, sold, ratified, and confirmed to the said Littleton Part, his heirs and assigns, forever, a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County aforesaid, on the south side of the three forks, beginning at a Red Oak, thence North to a stake, thence East to a stake, thence South to a stake, thence West to the beginning, containing five & three fourth Acres by the same more or less
