This Indenture made this twenty first day of May  
In the year of our Lord Christ one Thousand Seven hundred & ninety  
Eight Between Henry Taylor & Rebecca Taylor his wife of the County of  
Southampton & Parish of St. Lukes of the one part and Thomas Holladay  
Junr. of the aforesaid County & Parish of the other part Witnesseth that the  
said Henry Taylor & Rebecca his wife for & in the consideration of the  
sum of Three Hundred Pounds of good & lawful money of Virginia to  
them in hand paid on or before the sealing & delivering of these presents  
the receipt whereof we the said Henry Taylor & Rebecca his wife doth  
hereby acknowledge, hath granted bargained & sold aliene & confirmed  
unto the said Thomas Holladay & to his heirs & assigns forever one certain  
Tract or parcel of Land containing Two hundred Acres and bounded  
as follows, to wit, Beginning at a Hickory on the N. side Simmons Road  
thence running along the said Road Three hundred & Fifty Eight pole  
to a red Oak a corner Tree in Benjamin Lewis's line Then along his  
line one hundred & Twenty Eight pole to a small pine Then along  
the said Lewis's line then N. 51 West 126 pole to a pine in Browns  
Meadow. Then down the various Courses of the said Meadow Seventy  
four pole, then S. 67 East 18 pole to a Maple in a small branch  
of young of Browns Meadow then up the said branch 100 pole to a pine  
at the head of the said branch then a straight line to the beginning  
containing Two hundred Acres more or less To have & to hold  
the said two hundred acres land with all and singular the appurtenances  
thereunto belonging to the said Thomas Holladay his heirs & assigns  
forever to the only proper use & behoof of him the said Thomas Holladay  
his heirs & assigns forever and the said Henry Taylor & Rebecca his wife  
for themselves covenant & agree with the said Thomas Holladay
