- Item I give to my Nephew Epum Williamson Son to Arthur Williamson and Anne his Wife all my Lands in Brunswick County purchased of James Parham, John Sullivant, William Perry, & Joseph Wright. Containing about eight hundred acres of Land To him the heirs of his body Lawfully begotten forever.
- Item I give to my sister Anne Williamson forty Pounds Cash
- Item I give to my sister Olive Williamson the Plantation whereon I now live Containing Two hundred acres of Land also four hundred and forty acres of Land I purchased of Valentine White by John Johnson all and each of the said Tracts of Land to her and her heirs forever
- Item I give to my sister Mary Jordan the Use Profits and benefits of Two Hundred acres of Land and a Mill thereon Lying in the Isle of Wight County being the Plantation whereon she now lives for and During her Natural life Without any Molestation Interruption or Denial of any Person or Persons Whatsoever and after her Decease I give the said Land and Mill to the heirs of her body Lawfully begotten forever. I give to my sister Mary Jordan thirty Pounds Cash
- Item I give unto my Brother in Law Thomas Williamson all the Rest of my Estate after my Just Debts and the aforesaid Legacies are paid and I do appoint my Brother in Law Thomas Williamson Whole & sole Executor of this my Last Will and Testament Whereby Revoking all other Wills formerly by me made and do Ordain this to be my last In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this 30<sup>th</sup> Day of April Anno Domini 1753
