I Give and bequeath unto Brother William Whitehead a Tract of Land Lying on the South Side of Blunts Swamp which contains three hundred and twenty Acres to be held of him and his heirs forever

I Give and bequeath unto my Brother Jesse Whitehead a Tract of Land Lying on the North Side of Sawhenty Swamp in Johnsons County Which Contains one hundred Acres to be held of him & his Heirs for ever

I Give and bequeath unto my Brother Thomas Boon all my working Tools of every sort Like wise one English Dictionary Book to be held of him and his Heirs for ever

I Give and bequeath unto my Brother Lazarus Whitehead one Negro Boy Called Luke to be held of him and his Heirs forever I Likewise Give to my said Brother Lazarus one Gun

As for the rest and Residue of my Estate after paying my Debts I Give it to be Equally Devided between all my Brothers & Sisters that is to say Namely Tho^s Boon, Lazarus Whitehead William Whitehead Selah Whitehead Jesse Whitehead and Thomas Jones And I do here by Constitute and appoint Richard Vick Executor to this my last Will and Testament as Witness
