In the name of God Amen this 26th day of June 1760. I John
Bittle of the County of Southampton being sick & weak in body
but of perfect mind & Memory thanks be given to God there-
fore calling to mind the Mortality of my body. and knowing
that it is appointed for all men once to die. do make & Ordain
this my last Will & Testament that is to say. principally
& first of all. I give and recommend my soul into the hands
of God that gave it. and my body I recommend to the Earth to be
in a decent manner at the discretion of my Executors. nothing
doubting. but at the general Resurrection I shall receive the
same again by the mighty power of God. As touching such
worldly Estate where with it hath pleased God to bless me with
in this state of life. I give & dispose of the same in the following
manner & form

I give & bequath to my daughter Lucy Bittle the plantation
whereon I now live with one hundred Acres of Land adjoining
thereto. to her & her Heirs forever
