till my son John comes to the Age of twenty one years and then
for him to inherit the said Land and his Heirs after him -
but if my son John Wright should die without Heir then
for my Daughter Mary Wright to Heir the said Land

Item my Will is nobody shall Heir any part of my Estate during
my Wifes life only my Land to my son John at the Age -
twenty one years I likewise do appoint my loving Wife whole
and sole Exor of this my last Will and Testament whereunto
I have set my hand and Seal December ye 25. 1761.
