Will

I, J. J. Ford, being of sound mind and memory do make this instrument of writing as and for my last Will and Testament in manner and form as follows to wit

First I desire my funeral expenses and just debts shall be paid

Second I give to my daughter Sally my best horse one Bed and two Steers one pair of Sheeps one black cow one cow and two calves and two piglets all my things all my plantations tools and utensils all my kitchen furniture and cooking utensils one roe and Lamb and one cow and calves to her and her heirs forever

Third I give to my daughter Molly Pleasant one collier sheeps and her heirs forever

Fourth I give to my Grandchildren who are the offspring of my son Stephens Ford one dollar collectively one dollar to them and their heirs forever

Fifth I give and bequeath to my son John Ford one dollar to him and his heirs forever

Sixth I give to my daughter Rebecca one acre of my Black Cow and one cow and calves to her and her heirs forever

Seventh I give to my son Richard Ford one cow and calves one and Lamb and one Lamb to him and his heirs forever

Eighth I give to my daughter Nancy Alex one dollar to her and her heirs forever

Ninth It is my desire that my Grand daughter Martha Drury Ford shall have one Quarter to one fourth part in case she shall live with either of my daughters Sally or Rebecca or with both should they live together until the arrival at the age of twenty or years or married or while in either case. I give her one Bed and furniture to her and her heirs forever but if she should die unmarried under twenty one years of age in that case I give the said Quarter part to my two daughters Joseph & Nancy to be sold and the money arising from the sale to be given as it is between or their heirs

Tenth It is my desire that all my other property of every nature or kind not herein devised or given as aforesaid shall be sold by my executor for the purpose of discharging my just debts and the balance thereof shall be paid to my daughter Sally to whom I give such sum as the balance to her and her heirs forever

Lastly I constitute and appoint my son Richard Ford sole Executor of this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking and annulling all other Wills heretofore
