Item I leave one sixth part of my estate to the Grand children of my son John Barrell and should one of the said Grand children of the said John Barrell die without lawful issue the surviving him or him take that part of the dec^d her or him and in case all of the said Grand children of said John Barrell die without lawful issue that said part to be divided as follows one third to the heirs of James Barrell one third to the heirs of Lydia Bryant and one third to the heirs of my son John Barrell. Now I give one sixth part of my estate to my daughter Mary Lewis one sixth part of my estate to be divided as follows one third of said share to my son John Barrell one third to the heirs of my daughter Lydia Bryant one third to the heirs of my son John Barrell. Item I give one sixth of my estate to the heirs of my daughter Lydia Bryant and should one of the said heirs die without lawful issue the surviving him or him take that part of the dec^d her or him. Item I give one sixth part of my estate to the heirs of my son John Barrell and should one of the heirs of said John Barrell die without lawful issue the surviving him or him take that part of the dec^d her or him. Item I give one sixth part of my estate to the heirs of my son James Barrell to wit David Barrell and Benjamin T Barrell and should either of these for just named heirs die without lawful issue that the surviving him or her of said James Barrell shall possess the Legacy of dec^d her and in case both of the said heirs of James Barrell die without lawful issue their sixth part together with any and every part the said heirs of James Barrell die shall or may be entitled to by the death of any of the before mentioned heirs of my estate shall be divided as follows one half to the heirs of my daughter Lydia Bryant and the other half to the heirs of my son John Barrell. Lastly I nominate and appoint my son John Barrell whole and sole executor to this my last Will and Testament revoking all other wills by me heretofore made.
