

I give for the benefit of my daughter Martha and her children to be kept at interest by my Executor during the lifetime of my daughter Martha and that the interest arising therefrom be paid annually to my daughter Martha for her support and at her death it is my will and desire that the said two hundred dollars be equally divided between each of her children who may survive her. It is also my wish that the Negro man Isaac loaned to my daughter Martha shall not go into the possession of my daughter Martha or her husband Alexander during the lifetime of the said Alexander but that the said Negro be hired out for her benefit and the money arising from his hire be paid annually to my daughter during the lifetime of said Alexander and that after the death of said Alexander my daughter Martha be permitted to take the said Negro Isaac into her possession; provided nevertheless that her husband Alexander shall within three months after this Will shall be found and received release to my Executor the sum of five hundred and sixty five dollars out of his part of the money coming to his wife under the Will of Robert Watkins dec^d. But if he shall fail to make the said Release as above it is my will and desire that there my Executor sell the said Tract of land and the said Negro Isaac a (and similarly disposed of as above) upon such Terms as to them may seem proper and the proceeds apply as they are herein before directed in relation to my Southampton land on which Isaac live and it is also my will and desire that the two hundred dollars to be paid by my Son John Waddell for the benefit of my daughter Martha and her children be applied in the same manner of the said Alexander fail to make the said Release to my Executor as above.

5.th I give to my daughter Eliza Waddell my Negro maid Sam and my Negro girl Eliza (Daughter of a Nigger) and also my Negro girl Samet and the future increase of the two latter upon the Condition that she pay to my two grand children Mary and Joseph each the sum of One hundred and Twenty five dollars each (\$125 to Mary and One Hundred and twenty five dollars to Joseph) the said One hundred and twenty five dollars to be paid to the Guardian of my Grand Children Mary and Joseph within Six months after the proving and recording of this Will and not before.

6.th Such of my Estate be it money or other property as may remain after replacing all the money that I may have expended out of Robert Watkins Estate and discharging the Legacies herein given. I give and bequeath to John Waddell to him and his heirs forever.

7.th I constitute and appoint my Son John Waddell and my friend James Richello my Executor to this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking all and every other will be me heretofore made. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the 8th day of March One thousand Eight hundred and thirty Three.
