In the Name of God Amen I Hartwell Cocks being of sound mind & memory do make and ordain this to be my last Will and Testament revoking all other Wills I have heretofore made by this presents

Imp^{ro}visis; I return my soul to almighty god who gave it in a true faith of my blessed saviour and redeemer and an anxious hope in the resurrection and life eternal to come. - And as to my worldly estate which god has blessed me. I will and bequeath in the following manner (Viz^t) I give unto my loving wife Sarah Cocks all my estate both real personal and mixed consisting of lands Negroes both neat & course, Cattle and debts of a publick and private Nature Judgment &c. as will appear by Inventory taken by my Exors. to her and her heirs forever. saving and reserving what may be specially given by me to others in any further Clause of my Will the above Debts given to my said wife and her heirs do consist of bonds judgments balances of Taxes due me as collector for the county of Southampton for the year 1784 also as collector of excise in the District of Burgh Southampton and Isle of Wight for the year 1791 except those I gave Mr. William Urquhart an order on Col^l Fisher for as I have disposed of the Wagon and Team directed to be sold in my former will I shall only now add the remainder that I wish may be (Viz^t) one Phatun after being in some measure repaired one set of Hannes shetes and as many Hoes as my executors thinks can be spared
