one thousand seven hundred and ninety five I Richard Williams of the
County of Southampton being weak in body but sound in mind and
memory do Constitute make and ordain this my last Will and
Testament in the manner and form following V^s
Item I send unto my beloved wife Rachal Williams my Land and
plantation wheron I now live containing one hundred & eleven
acres more or less during her single life in widowhood also I send
unto my s^r Wife Rachal Williams one feather bed & furniture one
cow and half one mare one half of my Pewter one Pot one Sow and Pigs
during her single life in widowhood
Item I give unto my said wife Rachal Williams ten Barrels of Corn and
four hundred of Pork, also her legacy left her by her mother Hancy Alkins
Item I give and Bequeath unto my son George Williams after her death
or marriage my said wife Rachal Williams my Land and planta-
wheron I now live containing one hundred and eleven Acres more or
less to him and his heirs forever also two Pewter Dishes & half
dozen Pewter Plates one Pewter Basin one large Pot one small
blue chest one horse one Cow and half one sow and Pigs one bed and
furniture they and their increase to him and his heirs forever
