I give and bequeath unto my daughter Levisa Exum two negroes by the names of Isaac & Zilphas, one feather bed and furniture and Cow and Calf and two good Cows to her and her heirs forever

I give and bequeath unto my son Robert Exum two negroes by the names of Jesse and Esters, one feather bed and furniture one bay filly one Cow and Calf and two good Cows to him and his heirs forever. In which said Legacy it is my will and desire he shall not have in his Possession untill he arrives to the age of Nineteen years and it is my desire that this Legacy aforesaid shall be supported at the Charge of my Estate untill that time, and at his arrival at the age of Nineteen years it is my desire he shall have Possession of his Legacy and the free disposal thereof —
