 and her heirs forever. The rest and residue of my estate
 not heretofore disposed of is to be sold by my executor and the
 money arising therefrom after the payment of my debts to be
 equally divided between my sons Wilson Davis, Thomas Davis, Jesse Davis,
 and my daughter Sally Nick. It is my will and
 desire that the estate lent to my late son by my executor
 after her death except such as I have before given or otherwise
 disposed of and the money arising therefrom be divided between
 my sons Wilson Davis, James Davis, Thomas Davis, Jesse Davis
 and my daughter Sally Nick. I do hereby appoint
 Wilson Davis, James Davis, Thomas Davis and John Davis
 executors to this my last will & testament in testimony
 I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 10th day of July
 1815 Signed sealed published and
 declared this to be the last will and

 The last will and testament of John Davis
 dec^d was proved by the oaths of Noel Waddill & John Nick two of the

 county of So. ampton the 16th day of Dec. 1817 on the motion of Wilson Davis
 one of the executors named in the said will who made oath thereunto and
 together with John Demegree and Thomas Jones his securities
 entered into and acknowledge a bond in the penalty of fifteen
 thousand dollars condition as the law directs certificate is
 granted thereunto Wilson Davis for obtaining a probate
 thereof in due form. The other executors therein
 named refusing to appear in open court to take upon themselves
 the burden of the execution thereof.
