To Benjamin Lewis 1795 \$500 with interest from the day and the further sum of \$200.58 on 25 December next to a Treasury Paper who has lately returned with William Lloyd's \$120.00 with interest from the date and the further sum of \$350.00 on December 25 next To Robert Lewis the sum of \$185.53 with interest from the date and the further sum of \$25.58 on Dec 25 paid out to Archibald Lewis the sum of \$16.67 of which interest from that day and the further sum of \$285.58 on the 25th of December next. The Commissioner has been so advised that Benjamin Lewis' accidental account was reported by Commissioner Charles H. report 21 Dec 1795 which report has been examined by the Commissioner and found to be correct and is therefore made a part of this report also the said Robert Nicholls' administration has been up by me Commencing Dec 21/1795 also the Guardian's act of the same date up to Dec 21/1794 which is also made a part of the report all of which as respectively detailed in the said Master Com for 20 hours at 75[¢]

Also Court held for the County of Southampton on the 28th June 1794 the account between the Master Commissioner of said County of Southampton and the Guardian of the said Lewis against the said Robert Nicholls. Some objection was the day when made and ordered to be the matter for another trial at a Court to be for the said County of Southampton on the 17th July 1794 This need no account was again presented as heard and it appearing satisfactory to the Court that no complaint have been taken there. Therefore the Court has ordered by the Court the said account be made firm stable and binding between the parties by order of the Court on the 17th July 1794
