## HARRIS OF VIRGINIA AND GEORGIA

Absalom Harris, son of Faithy and Benjamin Harris, was born in Southampton, Virginia, May 27, 1752, and died in Hancock County, Georgia, November 9, 1824. In Southampton he married on December 21, 1774, Elizabeth, the widow Jordan, daughter of Andrew Tarver. (Wills, Northampton County, N. C., March 1780.) Elizabeth died between 1783 and 1784 in Greenville County, Virginia, and Absalom later married Clara Jeter.

Edmund Smith Harris, son of Absalom and Clara Harris, was born Oct. 24, 1786, and died Oct. 31, 1863 at LaGrange, Georgia. He was a planter. He married (1) Frances Hall, who was born 1797, died 1830. He married (2) on June 30, 1833, Mary Hamilton Church, who died April 7, 1859. He married (3) Mary R. Richardson on November 8, 1859, who died after 1861. Edmund Harris made his will May 27, 1861, probated in LaGrange, Oct. 24, 1863, in which he names his wife Mary(Richardson) and eight of his children. He states: "If my beloved wife Mary R. Harris outlives me, I settle on her as a homestead. . . . the place whereon we now live, and 300 acres; also bequeath her for her natural life a negro man Clem, a blacksmith by trade, and Eliza, a cook, his wifethe whole of my estate except the legacies heretofore createdshall be divided between my eight children: Absalom G. Harris, Clara E. Matthews, Mary J. McCurdy, Edmund J. Harris, Brittain D. Harris, Frances C. Allen, John T. Harris, and Joseph H. Harris. "His children Mariah, Martha, and Sarah, shown in the 1850 census of Troup County, Georgia, were not named in the will, so presumably had died between 1850 and 1861.
